Wednesday – Saturday 9.30am

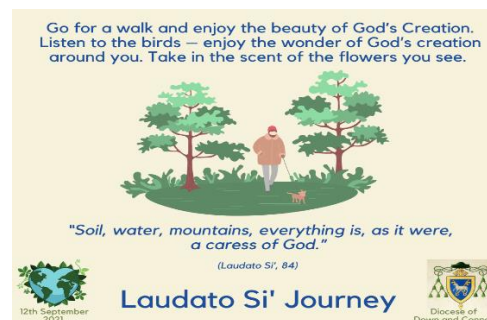
It remains mandatory for anyone attending Mass in

Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

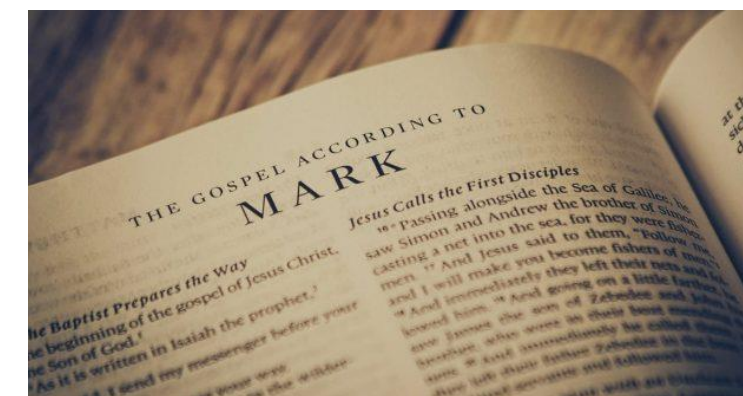
