A vacancy has arisen within Portstewart Parish for a Parish Centre Caretaker, 3 Coleraine Road, Portstewart. This post is being advertised as a job share arrangement.

The post holders responsibilities will include:

❖ Ensuring the Parish Centre and grounds are maintained to the highest standard, are safe, secure, and welcoming to all who use them.

❖ Opening and closing the Parish Centre and reporting all maintenance issues identified to the Parish Administrator/Parish Priest.

The terms are based on a permanent appointment of 2 part time officials on a job share arrangement which will be made up of:

• **Role 1 – 15 hours per week over Monday to Sunday** – work pattern to be agreed with the Parish Priest.

• **Role 2 – 15 hours per week over Monday to Sunday** – work pattern to be agreed with the Parish Priest.

From time-to-time flexibility will be required in relation to attendance and hours worked, in order to meet the business needs within the Parish and provide cover for the job share partner. Rate of Pay – £8.91 gross per hour.
