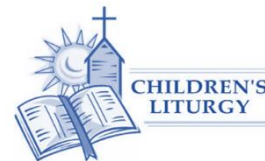

Laudato Si' week

Responding to the Cry of the Earth and the Cry of the
Poor. The week beginning Sunday 19 May 2024 has
been set aside by Pope Francis to reflect on 'Care for
Creation' with the theme 'Seeds of Hope'. It is an
opportune time to remind ourselves of the messages
contained within the encyclical Laudato Si'.

Pope Francis in *Laudato Si'* asks that we orient ourselves
to hear the cry of the earth, which is inseparable from
the cry of the poor. He writes, "a true ecological
approach always becomes a social approach; it must
integrate questions of justice in debates on the
environment, so as to hear both the cry of the earth and
the cry of the poor".

You are invited to reflect on this and pray:

Creator, you give us life.

Help us to honour you

as we care for your precious creation.

Redeemer, you give us hope.

Help us see new ways of living

as we turn from the path of destruction.

Holy Spirit, you give us unity.

Help us find strength in the love between us

Down & Connor Diocesan Novena to The Sacred Heart
Renew Our Hearts May 30th to June 7th, the feast of
the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

As Bishop Alan McGuckian SJ begins his time as bishop
of the diocese he would love everyone in the diocese to
join him in nine days of prayer, asking Jesus to give us a
new heart. Many people among us are weary or
wounded, hurting in one way or another. He wants us
to make a novena for each other, aware that we are
brothers and sisters in Christ.

The prayers will be available in a booklet you can pick up
at Mass or read online; it will also include a piece of
scripture and a reflection for each day for those who
wish to go a little deeper. Bishop Alan's hope is that this
novena will be prayed either individually or together by
parishes, groups, schools or families. Even young
children can join in with the short prayers!
